### **THE POWER OF 2%**

Since the founding of the American College Fraternity movement in 1776, fraternities have grown to symbolize leadership, independence, scholastic achievement and service to their various campuses and communities. Fraternity men represent a very small percentage, only 2% of the male population in the United States. However, that 2% is a very powerful group of individuals! Approximately 80% of the top executives of Fortune 500 companies are fraternity men. The majority (71%) of those listed in Who's Who in America are fraternity men. 76% of current United States Senators and Congressmen are fraternity men. 40 of the 47 Supreme Court Justices since 1910 have been fraternity men. 100 of 158 cabinet Members since 1900 have been fraternity men. All but two United States Presidents since 1825 have been fraternity men.
